1. Nicholas vicar of Thornton in Strata on the one part and Thomas of Oterington on the other Thus it is agreed namely that the said
2. Thomas granted and leased to the said Nicholas a piece of arable land lying in in the cultivation that was of John of Thornton namely from the churchyard
3. of the same town as far as a certain ditch towards the south which is called The Waterfall. And also an acre of meadow lying in the meadow
4. which was of the aforesaid John next to Northkilvington from the west part of Cotebeck (Cod Beck now). Holding and having the said land and meadow with common
5. pasture and with all its appurtenances to the said Nicholas to his heirs or his assigns. From the feast of St. Michael the Archangel in the year of grace 1319
6. until the term of the ten years next following fully completed. Rendering thence per year to the said Thomas his heirs or
7. assigns one mark of silver at the feasts of Pentecost and St Martin in winter by equal portions for all services and demands
8. beginning from the first term of the aforesaid payment at the feast of Pentecost in the year of grace 1320 and the said Thomas his heirs or his assigns
9. will warrant (line 11) will acquit and will defend the said land and meadow with the common pasture and all its appurtenances to the said Nicholas his heirs or assigns towards the lord bishop of Durham and
10. all others concerning farms (i.e. rents) thence owed and concerning all other customs and services which thence might be able to be required up to the end of the aforesaid term
11. In witness of which matter the aforesaid parties have affixed their seals to the present indentures alternately
12. with these witnesses John of Thornton, Hugh of Brayewath, Ranulf of Kilvington, Robert Fairandgod, Henry Paletis
13. and others. Given at Thornton in Strata on the Wednesday next after the feast of St. John of Beverley in the year of grace 1319
14. and the 12th year of the reign of Edward the King son of Edward the King.
