1. Know ye present and future people that I Roger Westeby of Boynton, gave, granted and with this my present charter
2. confirmed to Geoffrey of Norwich (Norwyco) chaplain and to John of Boynton one messuage in Thornton in the
3. Stret which certain messuage John de Burgh now holds and inhabits and three bovates of land with their appurtenances one which that is to say
4. John del Burgh now holds and another two bovates of land which John de Wystowe holds in the same town
5. to have and to hold to the same Geoffrey and to John of Boynton their heirs and assigns the aforesaid messuage and three bovates
6. of land with their appurtenances freely quietly wholly well and in peace in perpetuity making thence to the chief lords of that fee services
7. thence owed by right accustomed and in perpetuity And I truly the aforesaid Roger and my heirs we
8. shall guarantee and defend in perpetuity the aforesaid messuage and three bovates of land and their appurtenances to the aforesaid Geoffrey and John of Boynton their heirs and assigns against all
9. people In testimony of which matter I affixed my seal to this my present charter
10. with these witnesses lord Richard Tempest knight, John Waddaslee. John Couseby and others. Given at Thornton
11. in the Stert on the 15th day of the month of April in the year of the Lord one thousand three hundred and sixty six.
