1. Know ye present and future people that we Geoffrey of Norwich chaplain and John of Boynton gave granted and with this our
2. present charter confirmed to Roger Westiby of Boynton one messuage and three bovates of land with their appurtenances in Thornton
3. in the Strete which we lately had by gift and feoffment to the aforementioned Roger to have and to hold the aforesaid messuage and three bovates of land
4. with their appurtenances to the aforementioned Roger his heirs and assigns freely quietly well and in peace in perpetuity of the chief lords of that fee for
5. services thence owed and by right accustomed. And we truly the aforesaid Geoffrey and John and our heirs the aforesaid messuage
6. and three bovates of land with all their appurtenances to the aforementioned Roger his heirs and assigns as is aforesaid
7. We will guarantee and will defend in perpetuity against all men. In testimony of which matter we have affixed our seals to this present charter with these witnesses
8. Richard Tempest knight John of Waddeslay John of Couseby Radulf del Loundes John del Loundes and others. Given at
9. Thornton in the Strete on the Friday in the feast of the apostles Philip and James in the fortieth year of the reign of King Edward the third after the Conquest.
