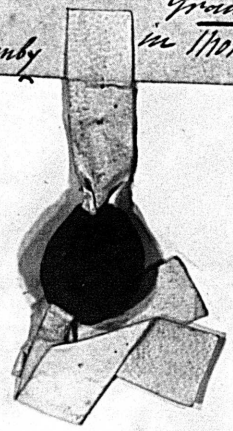

1. Know ye present and future people that I Roger Westiby of Boynton gave granted and with this my present charter I confirmed to Gerard of
2. Brumby of York and William of Brumby chaplain , two mesuages and seven bovates of land with all their appurtenances in the town and territory
3. of Thornton in the Strete having and holding all the aforesaid two mesuages and seven bovates of land with all their aforesaid appurtenances
4. to the aforementioned Gerard and William their heirs and assigns freely quietly truly well and in peace in perpetuity from the capital lords of that fee by services
5. thence owed and by right accustomed and I Truly the aforesaid Roger and my heirs all the aforesaid mesuages and seven bovates of land
6. with all their aforementioned appurtenances to Gerard and William their heirs and assigns as is said above we shall guarantee against all people
7. and in perpetuity we shall defend. In testimony of which matter I have affixed my seal to this present charter with these witnesses John of
8. Waddeslay John of the Lounde Radulf of the Lounde John de Burgh John de Wystowe and others. Dated at Thornton in
9. the Strete on Sunday in the feast of the Invention of the holy cross. In the fortieth year of the reign of King Edward the third after the Conquest.
