1. You should all have been aware me, William Tempest knight lord of Stodley by these presents, to have assigned and in my place to have been able (to have) those beloved
2. to me in Christ Alan Hosle and John Raa true and legitimate attorneys jointly and separately for deliberating on my behalf
3. and in my name full and peaceful seisin to Roland Tempest of all lands and tenements rents and services with their appurtenances
4. which I have in the town and territory of Thornton In the Strete similarly with one messuage with appurtenances In Northe Allerton according to strength
5. form and effect of a certain charter by me William Tempest knight to the aforementioned Roland Tempest completed confirmed and approved
6. to be held whatsoever my said attorneys will have done or either of them will have done in the premises or in any of the premises. In
7. testimony of which matter I have affixed my seal to the present charter.
Dated 12th day of May in the 18th year of the reign of King Henry VI
8. after the conquest of England. (1440)
