1. To all who will see or hear this indented four part charter greeting in the lord. Know us, John Lounde clerk Robert Danby Ranulf Pygot William Heron Robert Ingleton and Richard
2. Weltdown, to have surrendered leased delivered and with this our present charter to have confirmed to Dionisia, wife of William Maillorje esquire, sister and one of the heirs
3. of William Tempest esquire son and heir of William Tempest knight, our manors of Stodelay and Lynton with their appurtenances in the county of York and also our manor of Trafford with appurtenances
4. within the Durham bishopric and also all the domains messuages lands tenements rents services reversions and possessions whatsoever with all and singular their appurtenances which once
5. were of the aforesaid William Tempest knight in Stodelay Lynton and Trafford aforesaid and in the towns of Brompton next to Northalverton Coppedhewick aldfeld Wynkesley
6. Wodhous and Grantley on the north side of the Water of Skella with their appurtenances with the mill of the aforesaid town of Grantlay and the fittings of the pool of the same mill and also five messuages
7. lying in the district called Westgate in the town of Ripon and three acres of land in the same town of Ripon adjacent or pertaining to the same messuages with all and singular their appurtenances having
8. and holding to the same Dionisia, and to the heirs of her body legitimately procreated, from the chief lords of that fee by services thence owed and by right accustomed in perpetuity. We granted also and with this our present
9. charter we confirmed to the same Dionisia six shillingsworth of rent with appurtenances to be received annually of the holding of John Whixlay Junior in the said town of Ripon eight pennyworth of rent
10. issuing, and to be received annually, from a tenement ^in the tenure^ of Thomas Slother in the same town sixteen pennyworth of rent with appurtenances annually to be received from the tenement of John Croyser
11. in the same town and four pennyworth of rent issuing and to be received from the tenement of William Roche in the same town having and receiving annually to the same Dionisia and

12. to her aforesaid heirs at the terms of the payment thence usual on condition that if it should come to pass that the same Dionisia should die without heirs of her body legitimately procreated then after the decease of the same
13. Dionisia, all the aforesaid manors various messuages lands tenements rents services reversions and possessions with all and singular with the appurtenances wholly should pass to John son and heir
14. of Richard Norton and to Isabelle his wife, sister and other heir of the same William Tempest son of William and to the heirs of his body of John Norton himself legitimately procreated to be held
15. from the chief lords of that fee in the aforesaid form in perpetuity. And if it should come to pass that John Norton himself or the heirs of his body legitimately procreated should die then after the decease of the same John
16. all the aforesaid manors various messuages lands tenements rents services reversions and possessions with all and singular their possessions wholly should pass to Roland Tempest and the male heirs of
17. his body legitimately procreated to be held from the chief lords of that fee in the aforesaid form in perpetuity And if it should befall that Roland himself or the masculine heirs of his body legitimately procreated were to die then after the decease of the same Roland all the aforesaid manors various messuages lands tenements rents services reversions and possessions with all and singular their appurtenances
19. wholly should pass to John Tempest knight and the masculine heirs of his body legitimately procreated in perpetuity And if it should come to pass that
20. John Tempest himself were to die without a masculine heir of his body then after the decease of the same John Tempest all the aforesaid manors various messuages lands tenements rents services reversions and possessions with all and singular their appurtenances wholly should pass to the direct heirs of the aforesaid William Tempest esquire To be held from the chief lords of that fee
22. in the aforesaid form in perpetuity and for delivery for us and in our name to the aforementioned Dionisia full and peaceful seisin and possession from and in all the aforesaid manors various

23. messuages lands tenements rents services reversions and possessions with all and singular their appurtenances according to the strength form and effect of our present indented four part charter
24. We have assigned and in our place we have put the aforesaid John Whixlay and Richard Proktour our special attorneys together and separately by these presents to have approved and consented whatsoever our same attorneys
25. will have made or either of them should have made in the premises. In testimony of which matter to each part of this our indented four part charter we have affixed our seals Dated 4th day of September
26. in the year of the lord 1452 and in the 31st year of the reign of King Henry the sixth after the Conquest of England.
